STERLING FOOTBALL CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

The following guidelines will be enforced this season, and in subsequent seasons.

- 1. There will be <u>No smoking or Drinking</u> on the field or sideline, at **any** practice or game, by any coach or team official or parent. Non-compliance will result in expulsion from the league.
- 2. Players, coaches, Parents and <u>all</u> spectators will conduct themselves in a <u>Sportsman like manner</u> at all functions of the Sterling Football Club. Indecent language Negative comments, or gestures will not be tolerated. Appropriate measures will be enforced by the Board of Directors. And could result in removal from the fields and park.
- 3. No referee, lines person, or downs person to be approached or talked to before, during or after a game by <u>any</u> person affiliated with your team. This includes players, coaches, family members and other spectators. Non compliance may result in forfeiture of that game, and the next game as well. Violators can be expelled from the Sterling Heights Football Club. Disciplinary action will be determined by the Board of Directors. Any questions arising due to officiating must be presented to the Referee Coordinators and/or the League President by the head coach only.
- 4. Any player, coach or spectator ejected from a game <u>must</u> leave the premises immediately upon ejection. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the game. Any player or coach that is ejected may <u>not</u> be allowed to participate in the next game subject to a ruling by the Board of Directors.
