Lawn chairs only - NO umbrellas that stick in ground and NO TENTS

NO PARKING on the grass at any time, vehicles will be ticketed

NO DOGS ALLOWED INSIDE THE GATES AT DELIA

Reminder to all parents that ALCOHOL is NOT permitted in the park or in the parking lot at any time.
